

REACH conformity declaration

Dear Client,

In accordance with the European Regulation "REACH" No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals, which came into force on 1 June 2007, we are writing to you as clients of our company, in response to your request for information regarding how we are addressing the implementation of REACH.

The impact on us of the REACH regulation is as intermediate level users, according to REACH specifications, as we are not manufacturers or importers of substances or preparations.

In our role as a downstream user of substances and in accordance with our liability regarding REACH, we have contacted our suppliers of chemical substances and preparations, requesting them to inform us that they have proceeded or will proceed with the (pre-)registration of the latter, as well as informing us of any substance of very high concern (SVHC) that may be present in their products, according to the list available on the website <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table> with a concentration higher than 0.1%.

To date, according to the available information collected and issued by our suppliers, we can assure you that:

- The products do not contain any of the latest ECHA SVHC Candidate list substances above 0.1% w/w % at component level. The candidate list was last extended on January 15, 2019 and now it contains 197 substances.

- All of our suppliers and your suppliers intend to comply with the REACH Regulation and therefore substances that require registration will be registered by one of the suppliers along the supply chain.
- At the moment, no case of use of dangerous substances is known which would require permission for use (described in Annex XIV & XVII of the EU regulation 1907/2006).
- Furthermore, as a manufacturer it is our responsibility to ensure that our products do not contain "substances of very high concern" in quantities greater than 0.1 wt% (or 1,000 ppm); this is being complied with to date, with the available information collected, as well as the evaluation of the use of these products in our processes, and therefore a notification to the European Chemicals Agency is not required.
