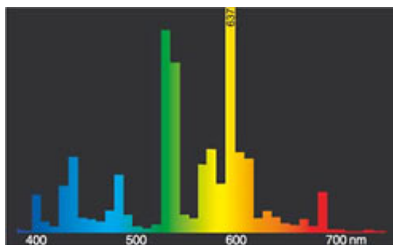

## Spectrum

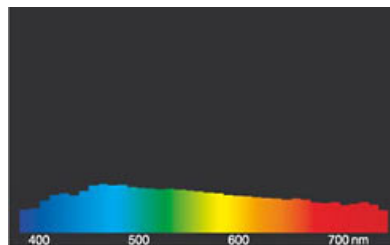
